### **CIRCULAR 6/2009: SUBMISSION OF FORM MDB1 OR MDB2 OR MDB3, AND MDB3 MEETINGS WITH MUNICIPALITIES THAT COULD NOT REACH CONSENSUS WITH LOCAL STAKEHOLDERS ON CERTAIN WARD BOUNDARIES**

The MDB would like thank all stakeholders for their participation in the ward delimitation process.

Despite the late publication of the formula, and the late publication of the number of councillors, the MDB, with the assistance of municipalities and other stakeholders, is managing the process so as to ensure that the final ward boundaries will be handed to the IEC at the latest, by 1 September 2010.

You are reminded that either form MDB1, **or** form MDB2 and the green map, **or** form MDB3 should reach the offices of the MDB by not later than **18 December 2009**.

Examples as to how to complete the forms are available on the MDB website [www.demarcation.org.za](http://www.demarcation.org.za) It is important that you ensure that all sections of the forms are duly completed. Alternative proposals in forms MDB2 and MDB3 need to be

described in detail. Detailed information as to which voting districts should be put together into your proposed wards, will empower the MDB to map your proposals for submission to the MDB, and to prepare for the MDB3 meetings.

Furthermore, it is important that the number of registered voters in each proposed ward is not less, or not more, than the number that is legally permitted.

**I wish to stress that only one (1) form needs to be submitted as follows:**

- **Submit form MDB1 if your municipality/stakeholders agree with the MDB's proposed ward boundaries.**
- **Submit form MDB2 plus the green map, if there is consensus in your municipality on alternative ward boundaries.**
- **Submit form MDB3 if no consensus could be reached in the municipality on one or more wards.**

**The forms should reach the offices of the MDB by not later than 18 December 2009.**

From 19 December 2009 to the end of January 2010 the MDB will analyse and map all alternative proposals as per form MDB2, or form MDB3.

Municipalities that have submitted MDB3 forms will be visited from Monday, 1 February 2010. A provisional programme for these visits is attached, but will be reviewed after the 18<sup>th</sup> of December 2009 so as to remove the dates for municipalities that have submitted form MDB1 or MDB2, or that have not submitted any form. Only municipalities that have not reached consensus and that have submitted form MDB3, duly completed and submitted by 18 December 2009, will be visited. The final programme for MDB3 meetings will be couriered and emailed to municipalities in January 2010.

***It should be noted that MDB3 meetings should not be regarded as public hearings, but merely as meetings during which differing parties present their alternative proposals on ward boundaries to the MDB as per the MDB3 forms, and to motivate their proposals. MDB representatives will then assist as far as possible by indicating which proposals comply with the criteria. Proposals not complying with the criteria, will not be submitted to the Board for consideration. Proposed wards with less, or more voters, than the minimum or maximum number of voters allowed per ward, will be rejected automatically.***

In this regard your attention is drawn to the following provision in Schedule 1 to the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998:

*“The Demarcation Board after consulting the Electoral Commission must delimit a municipality into wards, each having approximately the same number of voters, taking into account the following criteria:*

- (a) *The number of registered voters in each ward, may not vary by more than fifteen per cent from the norm, where the norm is determined by dividing the total number of registered voters on the municipality's segment of the national common voters roll by the number of wards in the municipality.”*

Requirements for MDB3 meetings have been set out in Circular 3/2009. Municipalities that have submitted MDB3 forms by 18 December 2009, are required to do the following, please:

- Book a suitable venue (see the dates in the attachment programme).
- Send invitations to the persons that will be making presentations, all councillors, and other relevant stakeholders such as the Provincial Department of Local Government, SALGA, the IEC, and any other local stakeholders that the municipality may deem necessary to participate in finalising the municipality's proposals.
- Provide a public address system, and roving microphones.
- Provide water.
- Provide a screen for presentations.

The Board, will as far as possible, chair/facilitate these meetings, but may, in some instances, require assistance from municipalities, provinces, SALGA or the IEC. Furthermore, MDB staff will have computers and the necessary tools available to test compliance with the criteria.

The MDB will not be responsible for any costs pertaining to these meetings.

It is suggested that meetings start, in general, at 10:00 on the day of the meeting, but if circumstances such as distances and travel time require a different time, it can be arranged with the responsible MDB representatives.

The following agenda is proposed for these meetings:

1. Opening and welcome
2. Presentations by differing parties on the municipality's proposals, and other alternative proposals.
3. MDB comments on the different proposals.
4. Agreement on preferred ward boundaries.
5. Completion of the GREEN MAP and From MDB2.
6. The way forward.
7. Closure

Presenters are required to hand in hard/electronic copies of their presentations/submissions to the MDB representatives.

If no consensus can be reached at the meeting, the GREEN MAP and From MDB2 should **NOT** be handed to the MDB representative. Differing parties will be allowed to reach consensus after the meeting, and to submit the green map and MDB2 to the MDB as soon as possible after the meeting. Alternatively, separate proposals can be submitted by not later than 2 April 2010. However, separate submissions are discouraged. Different proposals may result in the rejection of all the proposals, and the delimitation of wards as per the MDB's proposals.

It is the intention of the MDB to publish all wards in Provincial Gazettes as soon as possible. This may include the MDB's proposed ward boundaries for municipalities that have not submitted form MDB1, MDB2, or MDB3, and may also include some proposals already received from municipalities and other stakeholders. It is therefore essential that every effort be made to submit form MDB2 with consensus proposals

so that they can be considered by the MDB, and, if approved, be gazetted for objections.

The publication of ward boundaries in Provincial Gazettes for objections will not affect stakeholders who wish to submit form MDB4 – which should reach the offices of the MDB by not later 2 April 2010. All MDB4 submissions will be considered together with all public objections received.

With regard to objections your attention is drawn to the following provision in Schedule 1 to the Structures Act, 1998:

*“The Demarcation Board must publish its delimitation of wards for a municipality in the Provincial Gazette. Any person aggrieved by a delimitation may within 14 days of publication submit objections in writing to the Demarcation Board, and the Board must-*

- (a) *consider those objections; and*
- (b) *confirm, vary or withdraw its determination.”*

Please note that the onus is on the aggrieved person to object within 14 days.


I would like to stress that the MDB would prefer receiving from municipalities either form MDB1 (agreement with the MDB ward proposals), or, alternatively, form MDB2 and the GREEN map (locally negotiated consensus proposals) before 18 December 2009. **This is applicable to ALL metropolitan and local municipalities qualifying to have wards in the country, and the target date is unfortunately not negotiable.**
